

First Grade

Write name on the following

- Backpack large enough to hold a 10"x13" envelope
- 1 box of granola bars
- 1 box **each** of **addition** and **subtraction** flash cards
- 1 supply box (plastic cigar box size)
- 1 box of crayons (16-24 ***no more***) **to be replaced as needed**
- 1 box of Crayola **broad** tip markers (**10 BASIC** colors, red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, pink, gray, brown, black) **to be replaced as needed**
- 1 set of water colors (six basic colors)
- 1 box of colored pencils (small set 10-12 colors)
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors (child size) if your child is left handed make sure their scissors are also
- 3 spiral notebooks (70 pages wide ruled)
- 5 plastic folders with **pockets on the bottom** not the sides. **Will need to be replaced as needed**
- 1 set of dry erase markers
- one set of ear phones to work with in the computer lab

Do not write names on the following:

- 2 boxes of Ziplock bags (1 gallon size and 1 other size)
- 1 small bottle of white glue (no Gel)
- 10 glue sticks
- 1 **black** sharpie
- 1 **red** and 1 **black** gel pen
- **2 sets** of 2 "**My first Ticonderoga**" pencils (4 pencils total)
(This is a **large** pencil sold at Staples)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 boxes of baby wipes (unscented)
- 2 packages of 3"x 5" index cards
- \$5.00 given to the teacher to purchase Starfall dictionary and journal or like product

Items to donate: brown lunch bags Clorox or Lysol wipes (I use these to wipe the desks down daily and it keeps illness down.

You should purchase an extra set of markers, crayons, scissors and glue at home for homework projects.

I **also** suggest that you purchase and keep at home replacement crayons and markers for when your child's box needs to be refurbished. (Supplies are cheaper at the beginning of the school year.
