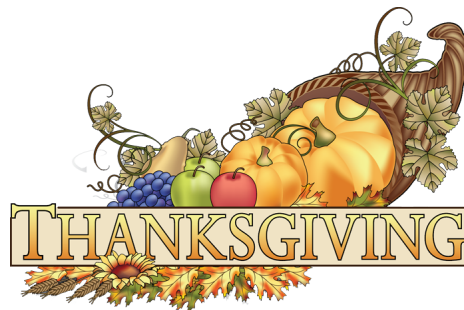

Since the upgrade with the system this year, as well as our transition to Standards Based Grading we want to make sure that all information accurately conveys your child's academic performance. The trimester ends on November 17th. We will close the portal through vacation until November 29th, reopening it to parents on November 30th.
